This week, we will have a summary of *Led to Worship Him with the Holy Spirit's Help*. Questions for this week's reading, *Led to Worship Him with Knowledge of the Truth*, Prayer Power and Word Power will follow.

In this chapter, we have been learning how to worship the Lord. The most important thing we can do is to bring our whole heart. When we do that, the Holy Spirit leads us in worship. He stirs our hearts and helps us to know how it should be done.

God wants us to *want* to invite the Holy Spirit to help us worship him. His spirit is a precious gift that He only gives with invitation from us. He won't force it on us. Worship is the key to hearing God. When we worship God, we open ourselves to the flowing of His Holy Spirit in us bringing into our lives the fullness of God's character. When we worship God, His presence is with us in power and we can better hear from Him.

The Holy Spirit knows the things of God because He is the part of the trinity of God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Through the Holy Spirit, God shares himself with us by pouring into us His love, joy, peace, power, and all that He is.

The Holy Spirit guides you not only when you pray, but also when you worship Him. He is your source of power so you can accomplish what you could never do without Him. He gives your life meaning and purpose. He illuminates God's Word. He guides you every step of your walk with God.

Questions for this week's reading, *Led to Worship Him with the Knowledge of the Truth,* Prayer Power and Word Power follows.

9. Read Psalm 119:18 and Psalm 119:24. Write out these two Scriptures in your own words as praise to God.

Psalm 119:18

Open my eyes, that I may behold Wonderful things from Your Law.

Psalm 119:24

Your testimonies also are my delight;

They are my advisers.

10. Read Psalm 138:2 and Philippians 2:16. What should you praise God for?

Psalm 138:2

I will bow down toward Your holy temple

And give thanks to Your name for Your mercy and Your truth;

For You have made Your word great according to all Your name.

Philippians 2:16

holding firmly the word of life, so that on the day of Christ I can take pride because I did not run in vain nor labor in vain.

11. Read Matthew 24:35. Why can you trust the Word of God?

Matthew 24:35

Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will not pass away.

12. Read John 16:13. Why can the Holy Spirit help you to worship God in truth? John 16:13

But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.

Read John 15:26. What is the Holy Spirit called? Where does He come from? John 15:26

"When the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, *namely*, the Spirit of truth who comes from the Father, He will testify about Me,

Read John 4:23. What does God want from true worshippers? John 4:23

But a time is coming, and even now has arrived, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for such people the Father seeks *to be* His worshipers.

Write out a prayer asking the Holy Spirit to help you be a true worshipper of God.

Prayer Power

Lord, I thank You for the truth of Your Word that shows me how to live. Help me to learn from it how to worship You in ways that please You. I praise You for forgiving me and making it possible for me to have a relationship with You forever. I exalt You, Jesus, and thank You that You rose from the dead and broke the power of death and hell forever in my life. Thank You for saving me from myself and making me alive in You. Thank You that You are growing me into a whole person.

I praise You, Lord, for the gift of Your Holy Spirit in me. I praise You, Holy Spirit, for guiding me in all things. I know that "Your righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, and Your law is truth: (Psalm 119:142). "I will worship toward Your holy temple, and praise Your name for Your lovingkindness and Your truth; for You have magnified Your word above all Your name: (Psalm 138:2). Help me to daily enter Your gates with thanksgiving and Your courts with praise (Psalm 100:4). Enable me to make worship of You a way of life —my first reaction to all that happens, whether good or bad. In Jesus' name I pray.

Word Power

The hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. --John 4:23
