This week, we will have a summary of *Led to Worship Him with Knowledge of the Truth*. Questions for this week's reading of the intro to *Led to Be Separate* in chapter five and *Led to Be Separate from All Sin*, Prayer Power and Word Power will follow.

The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father. He wants us to worship God in the truth of His Word. The Holy Spirit It is also the presence of God. When we fill our heart with God's Word, it reminds us of who God is and all He has done for us. It causes us to remember what Jesus accomplished on the cross. It teaches us about everything the Holy Spirit is doing in our lives. All this leads us to worship Him in truth.

God has a place for you to worship Him and grow with a church family. Ask Him where you are to worship Him with other believers. He wants you to experience the blessings that only come with corporate worship.

God gave us His Word so that we would know how to live and worship Him. He has rules so that we will know how to make our life work and be able to avoid things that will hurt us. He wants us to know the truth about everything. The ultimate truth is God's Word, which is unfailing, dependable and absolute, and in it you will find everything you need to know about how and why you are to worship Him. When you read the Bible, make a note of the names and descriptions of God. They will help you to honor Him for who He is.

Questions for this week's reading, *Led to Be Separate from All Sin*, Prayer Power and Word Power follows.

Read 1 John 1:8-9. What is true of us if we think we have no sin in us?
 If we say that we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves and the truth is not in us.
 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous, so that He will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

How do we get free in sin?

Read Leviticus 20:26. What did God ask of His people? Why?
 26 So you are to be holy to Me, for I the Lord am holy; and I have singled you out from the peoples to be Mine.

Read 2 Corinthians 6:17. What does God ask of us? Therefore, come out from their midst and be separate," says the Lord. "And do not touch what is unclean; And I will welcome you.

3. Read 2 Corinthians 7:1. What does God say to do in order to keep ourselves separated to Him?

Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let's cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

Read the following Scriptures. Beside each one write what we are to separate ourselves from.

Deuteronomy 6:14-15

14 You shall not follow other gods, any of the gods of the peoples who surround you, **15** for the Lord your God *who is* in the midst of you is a jealous God; *so follow Him*, or else the anger of the Lord your God will be kindled against you, and He will a wipe you off the face of the earth.

Deuteronomy 7:26

26 And you shall not bring an abomination into your house and become designated for destruction, like it; you are to utterly detest it, and you are to utterly loathe it, for it is something designated for destruction.

Write out a prayer asking God to show you if there is anything you need to separate yourself from now.

Prayer Power

Lord, help me to separate myself from all sin. Holy Spirit, I know You lead me away from sin, so I pray I can always hear Your voice speaking to my heart. Give me strong conviction in my soul if I ever hesitate to do the right thing. Keep me from being around anyone or anything that gives even the appearance of sin. Most of all, I don't ever want to grieve Your Holy Spirit. Keep me from thinking, saying, or doing anything that is in rebellion against Your ways.

Help me to be forgiving and kind to others. I need Your help because I don't always do or say things in a way that pleases You. Enable me to crucify any unholy desires. Give me strength to separate myself from all that is not of You so that I can enjoy a long and good life. I don't want to ever discover a wall of separation between You and me that I have erected because of disregard for Your will and Your ways. I reject all pride in me that even thinks I am incapable of sin. Keep me undeceived about that. Enable me to step away from any desire I have that could keep me from living by Your rules.
